Character / Color:

The coloring and structure of Santos rosewood are similar to the lively appearance of Rio rosewood. For this reason, Santos rosewood is increasingly used in place of the rare Rio rosewood. The strong hue ranges from yellowish red to violet brown. In Santos rosewood, the wavy violet to black tones are often interrupted by so-called "ears". The light yellow sapwood provides vivid contrast. Because the distribution of the color strips is so uneven, the wood texture can vary greatly.

Main occurrence: South American, especially Brazil and Bolivia

Usage: Exclusive furniture, high quality interior woodwork

Environmental: M. Bohlke Veneer harvests Santos from certified timber land in Bolivia. All Bohlke Santos veneer is exported with CITES documentation. This renewable and biodegradable forest product is environmentally friendly when it comes from well-managed forests. With forest certification, an independent organization develops widely accepted standards of good forest management, and independent auditors issue certificates.
